

## Saint Report Prep Homework



In order to be ready to write your saint report at school, you will need to do some work at home to prepare. This assignment is due **this Thursday, September 29th**. You will follow the same process as we practiced in school today.

**With a parent**, read through the information on your saint. You are asked to read through the information at least three times (or more). **You will need to become an expert on your Saint, and understand** what you read. That is why you will need mom or dad to help you with the reading. You should have your mom or dad read the information aloud to you the first time and maybe second time. Have them explain any words you do not understand. ***Make sure you read it also!*** **On your third reading, highlight the facts you want to include in your report. Try not to highlight the same facts in more than one article.**

After you have read the material and highlighted your facts, you will write a **sequenced list** of important facts or details about your Saint.

- Please **write (don't type) your list neatly and spell all words correctly!**
- **Skip lines** between the bulleted facts.
- Get facts from **all stages of your saint's life**, early years and adult. Include important dates, places and people in your Saint's life.
- **Be sure to include what deeds or actions made your saint a Saint!**
- Write your list in your **own words** . You should **understand and be able to read all that you write!**

- You should try to have at least 10-15 facts.
- Either write your list in order, or number the bullets in the order they will be written on your report.
- Thursday, September 29th, be ready to come in and start writing a report on the life of your saint using the facts you have written at home. At school you will use your sequenced list of facts to write a wonderful report.

You are **not** to write a report for this homework, only a **list** of important facts, dates, and events. You will use this list **at school** to write your Saint report in your own words.
