Ch.	Word	Part of Speech	Definition/Meaning
5	salutations	noun	(fancy) greetings
5	detested	verb	strongly disliked; hated
6	untenable	adjective	Unlivable
7	conspiracy	noun	A secret plan by a group to do something unlawful or harmful
8	vaguely	adverb	Not clear or distinct
9	sedentary	adjective	Not much movement; sitting still
9	boast	verb	To praise oneself; brag
10	gullible	adjective	Easily tricked or fooled
10	scuttled	verb	to move with quick little steps

<u>Directions</u>: Use each vocabulary word in an ORIGINAL, complete sentence. Each sentence should be long enough to give a clue as to the word's meaning. Make sure you are writing a SENTENCE, not the definition of the word. The words, their meanings and parts of speech are provided.

Example: stealthily: Templeton crawled stealthily along the wall so he wouldn't be noticed.

- · Be sure to use your complete paper heading if using separate paper
- · SKIP LINES between sentences if using notebook paper or typing
- UNDERLINE the vocabulary word in each sentence
