We are at the half-way mark of our novel unit! Let's review some of the vocabulary words that we have learned. *(At the end of our unit, you will need to be able to match each word with its definition. You will also need to be able to use words in sentences.)* This assignment is due on Friday, November 13<sup>th</sup>.

### Vocabulary from Chapters 5-10

<u>Ch.</u>	<u>Word</u>	<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition/Meaning</u>
5	salutations	noun	(fancy) greetings
5	detested	verb	strongly disliked; hated
6	untenable	adjective	Unlivable
7	conspiracy	noun	A secret plan by a group to do something unlawful or harmful
8	vaguely	adverb	Not clear or distinct
9	sedentary	adjective	Not much movement; sitting still
9	boast	verb	To praise oneself; brag
10	gullible	adjective	Easily tricked or fooled
10	scuttled	verb	to move with quick little steps

**Directions:** Use each vocabulary word in an ORIGINAL, complete sentence. Each sentence should be long enough to give a clue as to the word's meaning. Make sure you are writing a SENTENCE, not the definition of the word. The words, their meanings and parts of speech are provided.

**Example:** stealthily: Templeton crawled stealthily along the wall so he wouldn't be noticed.

- You may use looseleaf (notebook) paper, the back of this sheet or type up your sentences and print them out.
- Be sure to use your complete paper heading if using separate paper
- SKIP LINES between sentences if using notebook paper or typing
- UNDERLINE the vocabulary word in each sentence
- ONLY ONE vocabulary word per sentence
- Make sure you use CAPITALS and PERIODS
