Directions for the Charlotte's Web Poster

Your job is to go through the chapters of *Charlotte's Web* and choose your favorite quotes from each of the labeled characters.

- Neatly and carefully write the quotes in the correct sections. <u>Perfect spelling and punctuation</u> is expected!
- Write both the <u>chapter number and page number</u> after each quote you write.
- You must select quotes from different chapters.
- In the two bottom boxes <u>draw and color</u> pictures of two of the characters. Put <u>quality detail and effort</u> into the drawings and fill the space. Color with crayon or colored pencil. Color the other areas of the poster as well—making it look finished and appealing—such as borders. <u>No scribble</u>



coloring.

The poster is due no later than Wednesday, December 18th

Remember, you are to choose "quotes" from the characters. They need to be the **exact words** from the story. The quotes should **not be too short** and must make sense when read without the other text.

For example: on page 149 Charlotte says, "Yes, it's true." This quote does not make sense by itself, and is <u>not adequate</u> for this assignment. The book is filled with wonderful quotes---choose the best! Have fun.
